Synopsis – Capacity Building Sessions

Topic: Understanding the International Needs Assistance Programme (INAP)

Facilitator: Cromwell Awadey (Executive Director, IN Ghana)

How can we manage our assistance programmes to report meaningful and measurable outcomes? Cromwell will share practical approaches to implement a transition from the current benefits-based approach to an outcome-based approach in managing our assistance programme.

Topic: Spiritual Formation and Renewal

Facilitator: Kevin Mannoia (Pastoral Coach, The Rock Church, San Diego, USA)

Can who we are determine how effective we will be as leaders? The activity of leadership comes from a source that is deep in the formation and identity of the leader. We ignore that identity to our peril. Effectiveness comes in leadership when the foundation of who we are is well-formed and flows naturally into what we do. As we are formed in the unseen foundations of our lives, we are then prepared to engage, respond, and influence our people in strategic, Kingdom ways that has integrity with our nature and priorities. Topic: Financial Reporting

Facilitator: Edmond Vanderpuye (General Secretary, IN Global Office)

Does it really matter how we capture and share exciting stories of ministry in numbers and charts? Ed will share insights and expectations on stewardship and accountability as partner organizations and how to faithfully account for ministry operations and to disclose such results in a transparent manner. This expectation is also an obligation grounded in our covenant of partnership and the requirements of regulators in our respective countries.

Topic: Story Marketing and Impact Reporting

Facilitator: Geoff Weinstein (Director of Marketing and Communications, IN Canada)

How and why should we report amazing stories of God's work in words, photos and videos? In this session, we will explore how powerful stories of transformation engage donors. Geoff will share some ideas and practical examples that will help all partners demonstrate their impact and improve donor reporting and social media presence.

Synopsis – Ministry Panel Discussion

Introduction:

Our moderated panel discussion during Congress 7 provides an opportunity to celebrate how we have accomplished together as partners to promote our shared mission, encourage each other through the stories that will be shared, and learn from our collective experiences, challenges, and triumphs.

Panelists from each partner country will use the opportunity to share the impact of their ministry focusing on the sub-theme of the day. The daily sub-themes are Communications, Encouragement, Trust, Collaboration, Generosity and Stewardship. For instance, through effective communication between Support Partners/ Lead Partners, a livelihood project was started that has positively impacted lives in a number of communities. Another example could be through the collaboration of multiple partners, a sustainable community development project intervention has been executed. Building on trust within the global partnership that has made it possible to undertake co – ministry in any of our priority areas.

Approach:

The moderator will research the sub-theme and engage with a panel of four for the day prior to the live discussion. The objective is to get to know the panelists and gain an understanding of the stories to be shared. Since this is the first time of using this format for ministry presentations, it is important for the moderator and panelists to explore all possible perspectives and to sustain the conversation for the entire duration of the discussion.

For moderators and panelists, it may be helpful to generate stories using the **STAR** framework. The acronym STAR means - **S**ituation, **T**ask defined, **A**ction(s) taken, and the **R**esult(s) obtained.

Conclusion:

The beauty of our organization is our diversity, global connections and local experiences. Through the stories of our partners, we want to emphasize how we are accomplishing together to the glory of God and seeing transformed lives, changed communities.
